As our mission statement at the top of our newsletter states, we concentrate on providing inventor education and business networking for our members. A few of the many things we have seen this year:

- Our affiliation with the Inventor Groups of America. This organization comprised of group leaders and successful entrepreneurs in the invention process has given us solid connections to move your invention to a successful product. Most of the original members went to Washington D. C. this past spring and met with our congressmen to make them aware of the growing organization of individual inventors.
